On May 30, 1995, Complainant HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA), by and through its attorney, filed a motion to continue the hearing on the subject prohibited practice complaint with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Complainant seeks a continuance of the hearing scheduled for May 31, 1995 at 9:00 a.m. until after the hearing on the HGEA's Petition for Declaratory Ruling in Case Nos.: DR-02-58a, et seq.
