On July 3, 1995, Petitioner HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152 (HGEA), by and through its counsel, filed a motion to continue the prehearing conference and hearing in this matter with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board).
