
ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION  
FOR CONDITIONAL WITHDRAWAL OF COMPLAINT

On July 11, 1995, Complainant UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW), by and through its counsel, filed a motion for conditional withdrawal of the instant complaint with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). In the affidavit submitted in support of the motion, counsel for UPW states that the UPW accepted the Respondents' proposal to negotiate and bargain in good faith on the impact of privatization of the pharmacy at the Hawaii State Hospital. Thus, Complainant requested that the UPW be allowed to withdraw its complaint filed on May 4, 1995.

Pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-44, Complainant's motion is hereby granted.


