## ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT HGEA/AFSCME'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT

On September 5, 1995, Complainant HAWAII GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (HGEA), by and through its counsel, filed a motion to withdraw the instant prohibited practice complaint with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Counsel for Complainant states in an affidavit attached to the motion that the instant complaint was filed in order to litigate the meaning and legal effect of the confidentiality of discipline clause in the applicable collective bargaining agreement. Thereafter, counsel states that Complainant filed a petition for declaratory ruling with the Board in Case Nos.: DR-02-58a, et seq., for the same purpose. Counsel further states that Complainant seeks to withdraw the instant complaint for the purpose of economy of the parties' and the Board's resources and contends that its request to withdraw its complaint should be granted.
