ORDER DECLARING IMPASSE AND APPOINTING A MEDIATOR

On September 29, 1995, the HAWAII FIRE FIGHTERS ASSOCIATION, LOCAL 1463, IAFF, AFL-CIO (HFFA), by and through its representative, filed a Notice of Impasse and Request for Board Assistance with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board), stating that an impasse had been reached in contract negotiations for employees in bargaining unit 11 (Fire fighters).

Based upon an investigation conducted by the Board, pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-62, the Board determined that the above-named public employers agree with the representations of the HFFA. Thus, the Board declares that the parties have been unable to reach agreement after good faith

negotiations, an impasse in the contract negotiations for Unit 11 does in fact exist, and mediation is not being resorted to prematurely.

NOTICE IS ALSO GIVEN that the Board has asked the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service to provide a mediator to assist the parties in the resolution of their dispute. The Federal Mediator, Mr. Ken Kawamoto, has agreed to serve and is hereby appointed as mediator in the instant impasse.
