TO WITHDRAW PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINTS



issues in these cases and that the instant complaints should be withdrawn. Complainant's counsel also states that counsel for Respondents has no objections to the instant motion.


Based upon the foregoing, the Board hereby grants the withdrawal of the subject prohibited practice complaints pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-44.
