On September 1, 1995, Petitioner LEWIS W. POE filed a Petition for Declaratory Ruling with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). POE contends that he is involved in a class grievance and that the HGEA and/or his Employer are interfering and/or restraining the right to present a grievance to the Employer without intervention of an employee organization. In addition, POE contends that the Unit 03 collective bargaining agreement contains a grievance procedure which is partially invalid because it was not entered into in full compliance with the provision of Chapter 89, HRS.

On September 15, 1995, the HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA or Union), by and through its counsel, filed a Petition for Intervention with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board).
