ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW
PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT WITHOUT PREJUDICE

On January 5, 1996, Complainant HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA) filed a motion to permit the withdrawal of the subject complaint with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Complainant's representative states in an affidavit attached to the motion that the complaint is being withdrawn because the Respondent paid the affected bargaining unit employees for the days on which they were ordered to leave work. Complainant's representative also states that Respondent's counsel has been notified of HGEA's intent to withdraw the complaint.

Based upon the foregoing, the Board hereby grants the withdrawal of the subject prohibited practice complaint without prejudice pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-44.


