ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION; NOTICE OF PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND HEARING ON PETITION

On January 10, 1996, the BOARD OF REGENTS, University of Hawaii (BOR or Employer), by and through its representative, filed a Petition for Clarification or Amendment of Appropriate Bargaining Unit with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). The BOR contends that Position No. 80590, UH Director of Waikiki Aquarium, is a confidential and top-level managerial position which should be excluded from collective bargaining.

On January 19, 1996, the HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA), by and through its representative, filed a Petition for Intervention with the Board. The HGEA alleges that it is the exclusive representative of Unit 08 and thus has an interest in maintaining the subject position in the bargaining unit.

As the filing of the petition was timely and the HGEA has alleged a sufficient interest for its participation in the

proceedings, the Board hereby grants the subject Petition for Intervention pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-8(g)(14).

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the Board, pursuant to \$\$ 89-5(b)(1) and 89-6(d), Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), will conduct a prehearing conference on the subject petition on February 13, 1996 at 9:00 a.m. in the Board's hearings room, Room 203, 550 Halekauwila Street, Honolulu, Hawaii. The purpose of the prehearing conference is to arrive at a settlement or clarification of the issues, to identify and exchange witness and exhibit lists, if any, and to the extent possible, reach an agreement on facts, matters or procedures which may facilitate and expedite the hearing or adjudication of the issues presented. The parties shall file a Prehearing Statement with the Board which includes the foregoing matters two days prior to the prehearing conference.

YOU ARE ALSO NOTIFIED that the Board will conduct a hearing pursuant to §§ 89-5(b)(1), 89-5(b)(5) and 89-6(d), HRS, and Administrative Rules § 12-42-8(g), on the subject petition on February 22, 1996 at 9:00 a.m. in the above-referenced hearings room. The purpose of the hearing is to receive evidence and arguments on the instant petition and to determine whether clarification or amendment of the bargaining unit is appropriate.

At the hearing, the parties shall submit four copies of any exhibits identified and introduced into the record. Additional copies for opposing counsel shall also be provided.

All parties have the right to appear in person and to be represented by counsel or other representative.
