- 2) the complaint fails to state a claim for relief under \$\\$ 89-13(a)(2), (a)(3) or (a)(7), Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), since there is no requirement for notice from the Employer.

The Employer is directed to submit the proposed order to the Board within fifteen days of this order.
