After reviewing the record and arguments presented by the parties, the Board will dismiss the instant complaint. In order to assist the Board and expedite a ruling in this matter, the prevailing party, the DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, County of Hawaii (Employer) is directed to submit a proposed order, including proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law, reflecting the Board's ruling that:

 the complaint is barred by the statute of limitations because it was filed more than ninety days after the alleged violation;

2) the complaint fails to state a claim for relief under § 89-13(a)(8), Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), because the contract provisions cited do not prohibit the disclosure of the information at issue in this case; and

3) the Board lacks jurisdiction to enforce the provisions of the federal Privacy Act of 1974.

The Employer shall submit the proposed order within fifteen days of this order.
