PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINTS WITHOUT PREJUDICE



UPW seeks to withdraw the instant complaints because the parties have agreed to a stipulation of facts in a related case.


Pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-44, the Board hereby grants Complainant's motion to withdraw the subject prohibited practice complaints without prejudice.
