ORDER GRANTING UPW'S MOTION TO  
CONSOLIDATE CASES FOR DISPOSITION

On April 17, 1996, Complainant UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW) filed a prohibited practice complaint on behalf of bargaining unit 01 members against the above-named Respondents with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) in Case No. CE-01-301. The complaint alleges, *inter alia*, that the Respondents refused and/or failed to provide the UPW with relevant and necessary information as requested in a March 13, 1996 letter. The UPW contends that the Respondents wilfully violated

§ 15.09 of the bargaining unit 01 agreement which constitutes a violation of § 89-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), and prohibited practices under §§ 89-13(a)(1), (7) and (8), HRS.

Also on the same date, the UPW filed a similar prohibited practice complaint against the above-named Respondents on behalf of bargaining unit 10 members with the Board in Case No. CE-10-302. The UPW alleged that the Respondents violated provisions of the bargaining unit 10 agreement and §§ 89-13(a)(1), (7) and (8), HRS.

On May 2, 1996, Complainant UPW filed a motion to consolidate the foregoing cases because the cases involve substantially the same parties and issues. Counsel for Respondents notified the Board that he does not oppose the consolidation of the cases for disposition.


Based upon the foregoing, the Board finds that the consolidation of the cases will be conducive to the proper dispatch of business and would not unduly delay the proceedings. Accordingly, the Board hereby consolidates the cases for disposition pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-8(g)(13).
