ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING ON RESPONDENT UPW'S MOTION TO DISMISS AND/OR FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT AND PREHEARING CONFERENCE; NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED HEARING ON MOTION TO DISMISS AND/OR FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT AND RESCHEDULED PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On June 3, 1996, BERT J.K. SAM FONG (SAM FONG), by and through his counsel, filed a Motion to Continue the Hearing on Respondent UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO's (UPW's) Motion to Dismiss and/or for Summary Judgment and Prehearing Conference scheduled on June 3, 1996 with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Counsel for Complainant SAM FONG states in an affidavit attached to the motion that he was recently retained by Complainant and requires additional time to prepare for the motion and prehearing conference.

For good cause shown, the Board hereby grants Complainant's motion to continue the hearing on Respondent UPW's motion and the prehearing conference scheduled on June 3, 1996. In addition, the Board hereby continues the hearing on the prohibited

practice complaint presently scheduled on June 10, 1996 at 9:00 a.m.


YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the Board will conduct a hearing on UPW's motion on July 9, 1996 at 9:00 a.m. by conference call. Counsel for the UPW and the Employer shall appear at the Board's hearings room, Room 203, 550 Halekauwila Street, Honolulu, Hawaii at the designated time. Complainant's counsel will be contacted at his telephone number on file with the Board. Any written arguments in support of or in opposition to the UPW's motion shall be filed with the Board by July 5, 1996.

In the event that consideration of the motion does not dispose of the case, the Board will conduct a prehearing conference in this matter following the hearing on the foregoing motion.

Appropriate provisions of the notice issued on May 24, 1996 remain applicable.
