ORDER DISMISSING PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINTS


On May 29, 1996, at the hearing before the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) on the UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO's (UPW's) motion to dismiss complaint, counsel for Complainant JAMES R. SANDERS (SANDERS) indicated that the Complainant did not oppose the motions to dismiss filed by the UPW and the DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, State of Hawaii (Employer). Counsel for Complainant further stated that the Board was not the proper forum to address workers' compensation matters and that the Board lacked jurisdiction over these matters. Counsel for Complainant stated that he would withdraw the complaints within a week. Otherwise, the Board would dismiss the action based upon Complainant's representations.

To date, Complainant has not filed a withdrawal of his complaints. Accordingly, based upon the representations of the parties at the above-mentioned hearing, the Board hereby grants both the UPW's and the Employer's motions to dismiss the instant complaints.


