ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO CONTINUE
HEARING; NOTICE OF HEARING ON RESPONDENTS'
MOTION TO DISMISS PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT

On June 12, 1996, Respondents BENJAMIN J. CAYETANO, et al., by and through their attorneys, filed a motion to dismiss the prohibited practice complaint with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Respondents contend that Complainant failed to join indispensable parties to this action. On June 14, 1996, Complainant, by and through its attorney, filed a memorandum in opposition to Respondents' motion to dismiss the prohibited practice complaint.

Thereafter, on June 13, 1996, Complainant UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW), by and through its counsel, filed a motion to continue the hearing on the prohibited practice complaint with the Board. Counsel for UPW stated in an affidavit attached to the motion that he is requesting a continuance of the hearing presently scheduled on June 25, 1996 at 9:00 a.m. because of a conflict in his schedule. UPW's counsel further stated that opposing counsel has no objections to the continuance of the hearing.

For good cause shown, the Board hereby grants Complainant's motion to continue the hearing scheduled in this matter.


