ORDER APPROVING STIPULATION FOR STAY OF PROCEEDINGS


On September 12, 1996, the UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW) and BARTHOLOMEW KANE, by and through their respective counsel, filed a Stipulation for Stay of Proceedings with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). The parties hereto stipulated to stay these proceedings until moved on by either party with the understanding that pending a full hearing, a settlement or further agreement of the parties, the audio visual and automated systems electronic technicians represented by the UPW shall not be deployed, transferred or laid off by the Respondent to the extent such actions are covered by the scope of the subject matter of this complaint.

Based upon the foregoing, the Board hereby stays the instant proceedings until moved on.


