ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINE  
 TO FILE MEMORANDUM IN OPPOSITION TO MOTION TO DISMISS

On September 23, 1996, Complainant UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW), by and through its counsel, filed a motion to extend the deadline for submission of its memorandum in opposition to the Respondents' motion to dismiss with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). The UPW requests that the deadline

for the submission of briefs be extended from September 23, 1996 to September 27, 1996. Counsel for Complainant states in an affidavit attached to the motion that he will be unable to file the UPW's memorandum because two individuals who will be submitting affidavits in support of the motion are unavailable and also, the additional time will permit the parties to explore further settlement discussions. Counsel for Complainant also states that Respondents' counsel has agreed to the extension of time.


For good cause shown, the Board hereby grants Complainant UPW's motion to extend time to submit its memorandum in response to Respondents' motion to dismiss complaint.
