ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO EXTEND FILING OF ANSWER


On October 24, 1996, Respondent JEREMY HARRIS, Mayor, City and County of Honolulu (HARRIS), by and through his counsel, filed a motion to extend the time for filing his answer with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). HARRIS requests that the deadline for filing his answer be extended from October 25, 1996 to October 31, 1996. Counsel for Respondent states in an affidavit attached to the motion that he requires the input from the Chief of Police who is currently unavailable to formulate his answer. Counsel states that he is informed that the Chief will return to Honolulu prior to October 31, 1996. Counsel further states that he spoke with counsel for Complainant who has no objection to the request for extension of time.

For good cause shown, the Board hereby grants Respondent's motion to extend filing of an answer. Respondent's


answer is due on or before the close of business on October 31, 1996.
