ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT AFSCME'S MOTION TO
EXTEND TIME TO FILE POST-HEARING CLOSING MEMORANDA


On December 18, 1996, Respondent AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES, LOCAL 928 (AFSCME), by and through its counsel, filed a motion to extend the time for the parties to file their post hearing memoranda with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). AFSCME requests that the deadline for the parties to file their respective post hearing memoranda be extended from December 23, 1996 to January 14, 1997. Counsel for Respondent AFSCME states in an affidavit attached to the motion that he was

placed on medical leave by his physician and requires additional time to submit his memoranda. Counsel states that opposing counsel Cynthia Winegar, Esq., has no objection to AFSCME's motion but that Complainant SALEEM AHMED does not agree to the extension.


In view of the fact that the extension is due to counsel's medical condition, the Board hereby grants Respondent AFSCME's motion to extend the time for the parties to submit their memoranda for good cause shown. The post hearing briefs in this matter shall be filed with the Board on or before the close of business on January 14, 1997.
