On February 7, 1997, the HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA) filed three Petitions for Clarification or Amendment of Appropriate Bargaining Unit with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). The HGEA contends that the duties and responsibilities of Council Committee Aide, Position No. CK-112, in Case No. CE-03-211, Council Committee


Aide, Position No. CK-138 in Case No. CE-03-212, and Council Committee Aide, Position No. CK-184 in Case No. CE-03-213 no longer reflect duties of a confidential nature. Thus, the HGEA contends that the positions should properly be included in bargaining unit 03. The public employer for all three positions is Jeremy Harris, Mayor, City and County of Honolulu.

As these petitions involve substantially the same parties and issues, the Board finds that consolidation of the proceedings would be conducive to the proper dispatch of business and the ends of justice and will not unduly delay the proceedings. Pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-8(g)(13), these complaints and the proceedings thereon are hereby consolidated for disposition.


