ORDER DISMISSING PETITION FOR DECERTIFICATION

On February 26, 1997, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) issued a Notice of Proposed Dismissal in this case stating that the Board intended to dismiss the petition for want of prosecution unless objections were filed with the Board within ten days.

Thereafter, on March 7, 1997, counsel for the Exclusive Representative INTERNATIONAL LONGSHOREMEN'S AND WAREHOUSEMEN'S UNION, LOCAL 142, AFL-CIO (ILWU) filed a letter with the Board, stating the ILWU's position that there is no good cause why this case should not be dismissed.
