On April 10, 1997, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) issued a Notice of Proposed Dismissal in this case. The Board indicated that based upon previous representations that the matter would be settled, the Board would dismiss the complaint with prejudice if the parties failed to file objections within ten days.

Thereafter, on April 21, 1997, the parties filed a Stipulation for Dismissal with Prejudice with the Board indicating that they had reached a mutually agreeable settlement in the matter and therefore the instant complaint may be dismissed with prejudice.


Based upon the foregoing, the Board hereby dismisses the instant complaint with prejudice.
