ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S REQUEST TO CONTINUE HEARING ON THE ADVERTISER'S MOTION TO REVOKE OR QUASH SUBPOENA DUCES TECUM AND GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING; NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED HEARINGS

On April 21, 1997, Complainant, by and through its counsel, informed the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) that Complainant's primary counsel in this case was ill and unable to attend the hearing on the Advertiser's motion to quash or revoke subpoena previously scheduled on that date. Complainant thus requested a continuance of the hearing until a future date.

The Board granted Complainant's request for cause shown because of counsel's illness and rescheduled the hearing on the Advertiser's motion on April 25, 1997 at 9:00 a.m., in the Board's hearings room, Room 434, 830 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu, Hawaii.

Thereafter, on April 21, 1997, Complainant, by and through its counsel, filed a motion to continue the hearing on the merits of the complaint previously scheduled on April 25, 1997. The affidavit of counsel attached in support of the motion states

that Complainant's primary counsel was ill and in addition, has not received all of the records to be produced by the State of Hawaii in this matter. Counsel for Complainant also states that opposing counsel has no objections to the continuance of the hearing and further requested that all subpoenas previously issued be in effect on the new date and time if the instant motion is granted.

Based upon the foregoing, the Board hereby grants Complainant's motion to continue the hearing on the merits of this complaint previously scheduled on April 25, 1997.


