ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION FOR
WITHDRAWAL OF COMPLAINT WITHOUT PREJUDICE

On May 19, 1997, Complainant UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW), by and through its counsel, filed a motion for withdrawal of complaint without prejudice with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). The affidavit of UPW's counsel attached to the motion states that the contract between the COUNTY OF KAUAI and SANIFILL OF HAWAII, INC., is the subject of civil proceedings in the Fifth Circuit Court. UPW's counsel also states that this matter has been pending before the Board after the submission of supplemental briefs since June 1996. Accordingly, the UPW seeks to withdraw the instant complaint.

On May 23, 1997, Respondent, by and through her counsel, filed a statement of no position with regard to Complainant's motion to withdraw the instant complaint.


Based upon the foregoing, the Board hereby grants Complainant's motion to withdraw the instant complaint without prejudice pursuant to § 12-42-44.
