ORDER ACKNOWLEDGING IMPASSE AND APPOINTING A MEDIATOR


On July 1, 1997, the HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO, by and through its representative, filed a written notification to the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board), stating that an impasse had been reached in contract negotiations for employees in bargaining unit 13 (Professional and scientific employees, other than registered professional nurses).

The Board hereby acknowledges receipt of written notification that an impasse exists in the contract negotiations for Unit 13.

To assist the parties in the voluntary resolution of the impasse, the Board has asked the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service to provide a mediator to assist in the parties in the resolution of their dispute. The Federal Mediator, Mr. Kenneth Kawamoto, has agreed to serve and is hereby appointed as mediator in the instant impasse.
