ORDER GRANTING WITHDRAWAL OF
PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT WITHOUT PREJUDICE

On June 30, 1997, the UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW or Union), by and through its counsel, filed a notice of withdrawal of complaint without prejudice with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Counsel for the UPW indicated that the withdrawal was based upon a court-approved agreement which required Respondents to provide copies of all contracts to the Union within 45 days. Thereafter, on July 2, 1997, the UPW filed an affidavit of counsel with a copy of the agreement attached.

Based upon the foregoing, the Board hereby grants the withdrawal of the instant complaint without prejudice.
