ORDER GRANTING WITHDRAWAL OF
PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT WITHOUT PREJUDICE

On July 8, 1997, the UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW), by and through its counsel, filed a notice of withdrawal of the instant complaint without prejudice with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). The UPW indicated that the matter was resolved pursuant to Respondents' counsel's representations that the current workplace violence policy would not be applied to UPW members employed by the Honolulu Police Department and that no UPW member has been adversely affected by the policy.

Based upon the foregoing, the Board hereby grants the withdrawal of the instant complaint without prejudice.


