ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S REQUEST TO CONTINUE PREHEARING CONFERENCE; NOTICE OF HEARING ON RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO DISMISS COMPLAINT AND NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED PREHEARING CONFERENCE

In Order No. 1477, Order Granting Respondent United Public Workers, AFSCME, Local 646, AFL-CIO's Motion to Dismiss and Notice of Prehearing Conference, dated June 12, 1997, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) scheduled a prehearing conference in this matter on July 17, 1997, by conference call. Thereafter, on July 3, 1997, Respondent GEORGE IRANON, Director, Department of Public Safety, State of Hawaii, by and through his attorneys, filed a motion to dismiss the instant complaint. Respondent contends that the instant complaint should be dismissed because Complainant failed to exhaust his contractual remedies and failed to file a timely grievance.

On July 17, 1997, the Board convened the prehearing conference in this matter. At that time, Complainant's counsel requested a continuance of the prehearing conference in order to consult with his client to determine whether he wished to proceed


with this case. Complainant's counsel requested that the prehearing conference be continued until mid-August to accommodate his schedule. The Board thereupon granted Complainant's request for continuance. If Complainant wishes to withdraw his complaint, he is directed to file an appropriate motion with the Board, with affidavit attached, by August 1, 1997. If the complaint is not withdrawn, the Board will hear arguments on Respondent's motion to dismiss the complaint prior to the scheduled prehearing conference.

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the Board will conduct a hearing on Respondent's motion to dismiss complaint on August 11, 1997 at 9:00 a.m. by conference call. Counsel for Respondent is requested to appear at the Board's hearings room, Room 434, 830 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu, Hawaii, at the designated time. Counsel for Complainant will be contacted at his telephone number on file with the Board.

YOU ARE ALSO NOTIFIED that after hearing arguments on Respondent's motion to dismiss the complaint, the Board will conduct a prehearing conference in this matter, if necessary, on the instant complaint. As no prehearing conference statements have as yet been filed by the parties, the parties shall file a Prehearing Statement with the Board setting forth the issues, and identifying witnesses and exhibits two days prior to the scheduled prehearing conference.
