ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING ON PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT; NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED HEARING


On July 18, 1997, Complainant HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA), by and through its attorney, filed a motion with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) to continue the hearing in this matter. At the prehearing conference held on July 31, 1997, counsel for Complainant indicated that he required a continuance of the hearing previously scheduled on August 5, 1997 because of a forthcoming case to be heard before the National Labor Relations Board. Counsel for Respondent CARL WATANABE, Deputy Registrar, Bureau of Conveyances, Department of Land and Natural Resources, State of Hawaii (WATANABE) did not agree to the continuance.

However, upon considering the concerns raised, the Board granted Complainant's motion to continue the hearing in this matter.
