ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR
EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE POSITION STATEMENT


On August 4, 1997, Respondent JEREMY HARRIS, Mayor, City and County of Honolulu (HARRIS), by and through his attorneys, filed a motion for an order to extend the time to file his position statement requested in this matter from August 4, 1997 to September 5, 1997.
