TO STAY PROCEEDINGS PENDING ARBITRATION


On September 22, 1997, Complainant UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW), by and through its attorney, filed a motion to stay the proceedings with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). The UPW requests that the Board stay the proceedings scheduled to resume on September 23, 1997 pending the arbitration of grievances relating to derogatory materials. The motion is supported by a Stipulation for Stay of Proceedings executed by counsel for the respective parties.

Based upon the foregoing, the Board hereby stays the proceedings in the instant case pending the arbitration of the relevant grievances until further moved on.


