DISMISS COMPLAINT WITHOUT PREJUDICE TO FUTURE CLAIMS


At the prehearing conference held in this matter on November 18, 1997, Complainant MALIA DAVIS (DAVIS) and Respondent UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW), by and through its counsel, reached a resolution of the claims underlying the instant complaint. UPW's counsel represented that the UPW is presently pursuing DAVIS' complaint challenging her one-day suspension at the third step of the Unit 01 grievance procedure. DAVIS agreed to dismiss the complaint without prejudice to any future claims which may arise in the event that the UPW decides not to arbitrate her grievance.


