FOR INTERVENTION; NOTICE OF BOARD CONFERENCE

On December 4, 1997, the AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES (AFSCME), by and through its representative, filed a petition for intervention in this proceeding with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board. AFSCME contends that it represents members of the Hawaii Government Employees Association (HGEA), Managerial and Confidential Employees Chapter (MCEC) and that any decision in this proceeding will directly affect it. In addition, AFSCME contends that Petitioner MURAMOTO's interest is adverse to AFSCME's interest.

As the filing of the petition for intervention was timely and AFSCME has alleged a sufficient interest for its participation in the proceedings, the Board hereby grants the subject Petition for Intervention pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-8(g)(14).




