ORDER DISMISSING PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT


On January 23, 1998, Complainant notified the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board), by telephone, that he intended to withdraw the instant complaint because he was satisfied with the response received from the UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW) as to the reasons for not pursuing his grievance. Complainant also indicated that he would not attend the hearing on UPW's motion to dismiss complaint scheduled on that date. Complainant was instructed to file a written withdrawal with the Board.

To date, Complainant has failed to file his withdrawal with the Board. Accordingly, the Board hereby dismisses the instant complaint because the matter is resolved. As Complainant failed to follow the applicable Board procedures in withdrawing his complaint, the dismissal is deemed to be with prejudice.




