ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENTS' MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING ON PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT; NOTICE OF HEARING ON RESPONDENTS' MOTION TO DISMISS COMPLAINT AND NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED HEARING

On January 29, 1998, Respondents, by and through their attorneys, filed a motion to continue the hearing scheduled on the instant prohibited practice complaint with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). The affidavit of counsel attached to the motion states that he was recently assigned to this case and needs additional time to prepare for a hearing in this matter. Respondents' counsel also states that he has a previously scheduled hearing on February 6, 1998 and attempted to contact opposing counsel regarding the continuance but was unable to reach him.

At the prehearing conference scheduled on January 30, 1998, counsel for Complainant was unable to agree to any

continuance of the hearing. However, for good cause shown, the Board continued the hearing in this matter until February 26, 1998.

Also on January 30, 1998, Respondents, by and through their attorneys, filed a motion to dismiss the instant complaint on the basis that the Board lacks jurisdiction over the claims and because Complainants fail to state a claim for relief.


YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that pursuant to §§ 89-5(b)(4) and (5), Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), and Administrative Rules § 12-42-8, the Board will conduct a hearing on Respondents' motion to dismiss complaint on February 6, 1998 at 9:00 a.m., in the Board's hearings room, Room 434, 830 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu, Hawaii. If the motion is denied, the Board will thereafter conduct a prehearing conference in this matter.

YOU ARE ALSO NOTIFIED that pursuant to §§ 89-5(b)(4) and (5), and 89-14, HRS, and Administrative Rules §§ 12-42-49 and 12-42-8(g), the Board will conduct a hearing on the instant complaint on February 26, 1998 at 9:00 a.m. in the above-mentioned hearings room.

Appropriate provisions of the notice issued on January 9, 1998 remain applicable.


