On March 4, 1998, Respondents, by and through their attorneys, filed a motion to continue the hearing on the motion to dismiss prohibited practice complaint and prehearing conference presently scheduled on March 10, 1998 at 9:00 a.m. with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board).
