
ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION
TO WITHDRAW PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT

On March 25, 1998, Complainant HAWAII STATE TEACHERS ASSOCIATION (HSTA), by and through its counsel, filed a motion to withdraw its prohibited practice complaint filed on March 3, 1998 with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Complainant seeks to withdraw the instant complaint in light of the Board's Order No. 1603, Order Dismissing Petition for Declaratory Ruling, issued in Case No. DR-05-70.
