Thereafter, counsel for Respondents indicated that she has no objections to the continuance.


YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the Board will conduct a status conference on the instant complaint on May 14, 1998 at

9:15 a.m. in the Board's hearings room, Room 434, 830 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu, Hawaii.


YOU ARE ALSO NOTIFIED that the Board will also consider Respondents' motion to dismiss the complaint filed with the Board on March 23, 1998.
