DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF POST-HEARING MEMORANDA


On May 18, 1998, Respondents, by and through their counsel, filed a motion to extend the deadline for submission of

Counsel further agreed that any extension would be irrespective of any other deadlines for the submission of any motion, opposition or reply relating to a request for interlocutory relief.
