ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW  
PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT WITHOUT PREJUDICE

On May 19, 1998, Complainant STATE OF HAWAII ORGANIZATION OF POLICE OFFICERS (SHOPO), by and through its counsel, filed a motion to withdraw its prohibited practice complaint filed on April 22, 1998 with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Complainant's counsel states in an affidavit attached to the motion that during the prehearing conference held on May 18, 1998, Ted H.S. Hong, Assistant Corporation Counsel, County of Hawaii raised the issue of the sufficiency of SHOPO's Notice of Intent to Negotiate. Complainant's counsel states that SHOPO will comply with § 89-9(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) and will, if necessary, refile a complaint.

Based upon the foregoing, the Board hereby grants Complainant's motion to withdraw the instant complaint without prejudice.
