ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO
CONTINUE HEARING; NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED HEARING

On May 7, 1998, Complainant filed a motion to continue the hearing scheduled for May 8, 1998 in this matter with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Complainant requested a continuance to a date no earlier than May 22, 1998 and preferably no later than May 29, 1998. Complainant states in his Declaration attached to the motion that William H. Elkner, Esq., has agreed to represent him at the hearing on the condition that the hearing is continued for at least two weeks. Complainant further states that Mr. Elkner's office informed him that counsel for Respondent JAMES TAKUSHI agreed to the continuance but counsel for RUSSELL OKATA could not stipulate to a continuance.


Based on the foregoing, in order to permit Complainant to be represented by counsel, the Board, in its discretion and in the


interests of justice hereby grants Complainant's motion to continue the hearing.
