## ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING ON MOTION TO DISMISS; NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED HEARING ON RESPONDENT'S MOTION TO DISMISS

On June 4, 1998, Respondent, by and through his counsel, filed a motion to continue the hearing on Respondent's motion to dismiss scheduled on June 19, 1998 with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Respondent's counsel states in an affidavit attached to the motion that she has a conflict in her schedule and will be out-of-state at the designated time. Counsel further states that she will be available for a hearing on June 24, 1998.

On June 8, 1998, Complainant filed a Request to Hold in Abeyance Board's Hearing on Respondent's Motion to Dismiss with the Board. Complainant indicates that the parties have agreed in principle to settle this complaint and are working out the details of an agreement. Complainant thus requests that the hearing be held in abeyance subject to recall.

After considering the record, the Board hereby grants Respondent's motion to continue the hearing. However, since

important jurisdictional arguments are raised by Respondents, the Board will reschedule the hearing on Respondent's Motion to Dismiss but will allow the parties one month to resolve this matter.

Complainant will be contacted at the telephone number on file with the Board's offices.
