## ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR PARTICULARIZATION OF COMPLAINTS

On January 25, 1978, Respondent, Hawaii State Teachers Association, NEA, filed a motion for particularization of the charges filed in the above-referenced cases. Along with the motion, the HSTA's attorney filed a supporting affidavit.

Upon a review of the aforesaid affidavit and motion and the charges set forth in the complaints herein, the Board is of the opinion that the subject motion should be granted.

The Board directs the Complainants to serve upon the Respondent one copy and to file with the Board, with certification of service, the original and five (5) copies of the particularization requested in the HSTA's motion no later than 4:30 p.m., Tuesday, February 7, 1978. If the Complainants fail to timely file said particularization, the Board shall dismiss their complaints.

The Respondent is directed to serve upon the Complainants one copy and to file with the Board, with certification of service, the original and five (5) copies of its answer to the particularization no later than 4:30p.m., Wednesday, February 15, 1978. If the Respondent fails to timely file its answer, such failure shall constitute an admission of the material facts alleged in the complaint and particularization and a waiver of a hearing.
