ORDER DISMISSING CASE

On May 27, 1977, the instant prohibited practice charges were filed with the Board by the University of Hawaii Professional Assembly (hereinafter UHPA). The complaint alleged that the Employer's failure to consult with UHPA on the interpretation of a Board of Regents policy document violated Sections 89-9(c), 89-13(a)(1), and 89-13(a)(7), Hawaii Revised Statutes.

At the hearing scheduled for January 24, 1978, the parties advised the Board that they had reached agreement over the issues in the case, and these prohibited practice charges would be withdrawn. A copy of the parties' settlement agreement, containing the preceding provisions, was filed by UHPA on February 6, 1978.

In view of the foregoing, Case No. CE-07-35 is hereby dismissed with prejudice.
