ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION AND DIRECTING
SERVICE OF MEMORANDUM UPON INTERVENOR

On February 9, 1978, the Hawaii Government Employees'
Association (hereafter HGEA) petitioned to intervene in this case solely on the issue raised by the Board in its Order No. 167; "to-wit: Whether HPERB, on its own motion or the motion of anyone, particularly employees who were not parties to service fee proceedings, may review HPERB's decision concerning service fees."

The petition to intervene respecting said issue is hereby granted.

The petitioning employees who seek a review of this Board's Decision 69 have been directed, in Order 167, to file an opening memorandum of law on the subject issue no later than 4:30 p.m., Friday, February 17, 1978, together with certification of service upon the HSTA. They are also hereby directed to serve a copy of their memorandum upon Yukio Naito, counsel for the HGEA.

The HGEA may file an answering memorandum no later than 4:30 p.m., Friday, March 10, 1978, with certification of service upon counsel for the petitioning employees.

A reply memorandum may be filed by the petitioning employees no later than 4:30 p.m., Monday, March 20, 1978.
