ORDER GRANTING PETITION FOR
INTERVENTION; NOTICE OF BOARD CONFERENCE

On May 27, 1999, the United Public Workers, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW), by and through its counsel, filed a Petition for Intervention with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). The UPW alleges that it is the exclusive representative of the bargaining unit affected by this petition. The UPW contends that it has a direct interest in the proceedings since it is a party to the Unit 01 collective bargaining agreement at issue and Petitioner STEPHEN YAMASHIRO seeks remedies against the UPW. The UPW further alleges that no other party can adequately represent its interest and that this petition arises in part from a pending complaint filed by the UPW in Case No. CE-01-402.


Based upon the foregoing, the Board finds that the UPW has timely filed its petition to intervene in these proceedings and has alleged a sufficient interest to participate in these proceedings. The Board finds that the UPW will assist the Board in

developing a sound record in this case. Accordingly, the Board hereby grants the UPW's Petition for Intervention pursuant to Administrative Rules § 12-42-8(g) (14).

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the Board will meet with the parties on June 23, 1999 at 9:00 a.m. in the Board's hearings room, Room 434, 830 Punchbowl Street, to discuss the procedures to be followed in the instant matter. The conference may be held by conference call at the option of Petitioner. Intervenor's counsel shall appear at the Board's hearings room at the designated time.
