


ORDER GRANTING COMPLAINANT'S MOTION

On July 29, 1999, Complainant, by and through its counsel, filed a motion to approve the withdrawal of the instant complaint pursuant to a settlement of the parties and to cancel the hearing scheduled in this matter with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Complainant's counsel states in an affidavit attached to the motion that the parties entered into a memorandum of agreement (MOA) containing the terms of the resolution of the instant dispute over compliance with Arbitrator Patrick Yim's arbitration award regarding the retention of derogatory materials. Complainant's counsel further states that in accordance with the MOA, Complainant requests that the Board approve the withdrawal of the complaint and cancel the hearing scheduled in this matter on August 3, 1999.


Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby grants Complainant's motion and approves the withdrawal of the instant complaint.
