ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENTS' MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING
DATE; NOTICE OF HEARING ON RESPONDENTS' MOTION TO DISMISS
PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT AND/OR FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

At the prehearing conference held in this matter on August 23, 1999, the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board) scheduled the hearing on the instant complaint on September 8, 1999 at 9:00 a.m. in the Board's hearings room. In addition, the Board indicated that if any party filed a dispositive motion by August 27, 1999, the hearing on the motion would be held on that date.

Thereafter, on August 27, 1999, Respondents, by and through their counsel, filed a motion to dismiss the prohibited practice complaint and/or for summary judgment with the Board. Respondents contend that Complainant failed to exhaust its

contractual remedies and has also failed to state a claim upon which relief can be granted.


Also on August 27, 1999, Respondents filed a motion to continue the hearing date with the Board. Respondents' counsel states, in an affidavit attached to the motion, that she has a conflict in her schedule and requests a continuance of the hearing until September 15, 1999. Respondents' counsel further states that opposing counsel agrees to the continuance of the hearing.

Based upon the foregoing, the Board hereby grants Respondents' motion to continue the hearing date in the instant case.

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that the hearing on Respondents' motion to dismiss the complaint and/or for summary judgment is scheduled on September 15, 1999 at 9:00 a.m., in the Board's hearings room, Room 434, 830 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu, Hawaii.
