ORDER GRANTING UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII
PROFESSIONAL ASSEMBLY'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW COMPLAINT


On September 7, 1999, Complainant UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII PROFESSIONAL ASSEMBLY (Union), by and through its counsel, filed a motion to withdraw the instant prohibited practice complaint with the Hawaii Labor Relations Board (Board). Complainant's counsel states in an affidavit attached to the motion that the complaint alleged that the Respondent BOARD OF REGENTS, University of Hawaii, State of Hawaii violated §§ 89-13(a)(5) and (8), Hawaii Revised Statutes, by failing to meet with the Union to select arbitrators for two grievances. Complainant's counsel further states that the arbitrators have been selected for the two grievances and that there are no issues remaining to be resolved. Thus, the Union requests the Board to approve its request to withdraw the complaint.

Based on the foregoing, the Board hereby grants the Union's motion to withdraw the instant complaint.
